**"Alberta Court of Appeal sets aside acquittal in Cindy Gladue case, which drew national outrage"**  
 This case has exposed the flaws in the **found in sexual** infrastructure used for instructing judges on sexual offences in Canada.

**When the battered body of Nina Louise Courtpatte was found deserted on the fairway of an Edmonton-area golf course, the aboriginal teenager's grisly video of slain teen draws tears in courtroom**  
 RCMP videotape of the crime scene and the body of the 13-year-old aspiring model and dancer released to news yesterday, as the trial for two men accused of killing her, Michael Briscoe, 36, and Joseph Laboucan, 21, began in an Edmonton court.  
 At least two people, including Nina Louise's older brother, had the courtroom until the videotape concluded.  
 Police allege that the premeditated sex slaying occurred on or around April 3, 2005.  
 The teenager's body, which was clothed in a black hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans, was found by staff at the Edmonton Springs Golf Course a day later.

**Amber Tuccaro's unsolved death of a 16-year-old girl recognize this voice?**  
 "Man in recording may have answers to unsolved murder near Edmonton five years ago"  
 Unravelling the mysterious disappearance and unsolved murder of Amber Tuccaro could hinge on identifying a man whose voice was captured in a recording of her last phone conversation, new details of which her family has revealed to CBC News.  
 Tuccaro was staying to the site where her body was found two years later.  
 The 20-year-old mother from the Mistew Cree First Nation in Alberta vanished almost five years ago, after getting into an unknown man's vehicle in Nisku, near Edmonton.  
 "On Sept. 4, 2010, less than three weeks after Tuccaro's disappearance, a media relations officer with Leduc RCMP was quoted in a local newspaper saying, 'We don't have any reason to believe she is any danger. We know that she is in the Edmonton area.'"  
 Police also removed Tuccaro's name from its list of missing persons and, without informing her family, destroyed her belongings, which had been left at the motel in Nisku.  
 "Let's just say that's not best practice and something that shouldn't have happened but did," says Schlosser. The RCMP later apologized to Tuccaro's family.  
 "It's all the systems... children and youth... found Mr. Tuccaro not guilty"

**Tina Fontaine: Raymond Cormier not guilty of Red River murder**  
 "A Canadian man has been found not guilty in the death of indigenous teenager Tina Fontaine."  
 Raymond Cormier, 36, was charged with second-degree murder in the death of the 15-year-old in 2015.  
 Ms. Fontaine's body was pulled from Winnipeg's Red River on 17 August 2014, a week after she was reported missing.  
**"Her death renewed calls from activists to launch an inquiry into missing and murdered indigenous women and girls in Canada."**  
 Police have described Ms. Fontaine as "highly vulnerable" and said she was exploited during her time on the run. She was in the care of the child welfare system in Winnipeg, Manitoba, when she disappeared.
