... growth of Indigenous youth compared to 6% of non-indigenous youth over the last 12 years.


Individuals can be impacted by low income, lower-quality jobs, little value to education, low selfesteem and an impact to their personal health

## Globally

#### Australia

- The Australian Government promised to provide record levels of funding for Indigenous students. They will grow its record level of recurrent funding for schools from \$17.5 in 2017 to \$31.4 billion in 2029.
- Indigenous students will also greatly benefit from the Australian Government being committed to closing the gap between indigenous and nonindigenous students






